





*Mary* lived with old people. She lived in *Koufukuen*, a special home for old people. She arrived there about 15 years ago. She usually stayed in a big room but at night she slept in her own house in the home. Everyone in the home loved her very much.

Mr. Sato, the manager of the home, decided to keep *Mary*. Many people didn't like this idea. They said to him, "Keeping a dog will make the home dirty and someone will have to take care of her." But soon they noticed ① some changes in the home. Before *Mary* came, about half of the old people stayed in their beds all day. They didn't want to do anything. But after she came, these people got out of their beds and came to touch and talk to her. They enjoyed talking to her and talking with each other about her.

About 5 years ago, *Mary* died suddenly. The old people were sad and cried. Each of them brought a flower to thank her and to say good-bye. Mr. Sato says, "We were all very sad when *Mary* died. But it was a good chance for the old people to think about death. They knew they would die some day and they felt lonely. But now, after *Mary's* death ② they don't feel lonely, because they saw many people felt sad and cried for *Mary*. They understood that many people would feel sad and cry when they died, too."

What did *Mary* do for the old people? She didn't do anything special for them. She only walked and sat among the old people. She was always near them. <u>3</u> That was all *Mary* did. The old people enjoyed doing something for her. *Mary* wagged her tail happily when they touched and talked to her. The old people felt happy when she looked happy. *Mary* gave them the power to live actively. She was also happy to live with them. The old people and *Mary* needed each other.

We can live actively when we have someone or something near us. It may be animals, flowers or nature itself. Each of us also can give each other the power to live actively. *Mary* shows us what we should do. We can't live without each other.

Now in *Koufukuen*, Helen lives with the old people, like her mother *Mary*.
