

The Sagrada Familia is a symbol of Barcelona. The church attracts three million tourists a year and is considered to be the great artwork of the city's most famous architect, Antoni Gaudi. It's a beautiful building, even though the workers [ ① ].

They started building it in 1882. However, when Gaudi died in ( **A** ), the building was only a quarter completed. He left his plans and models so that those people who followed him could continue with his work. However, during the Spanish Civil War, ② some of the plans were destroyed by a fire. Since 1940, the architects have continued the work with improved versions of the original plans.

Well, they've now finished about 70% of the project. They have already built 8 towers, but 10 more are left. They've just started building the central tower, and it will be 170m tall. So, the Sagrada Familia will be the tallest church in the world. And if the plans are successful, they will finish the project in 2026, almost 150 years after the first stone was set and exactly 100 years after the death of its famous architect, Gaudi.

But what about you? What project are you doing right now? Maybe you have a big project at school or work, or maybe you have some New Year's resolutions to share? Some of the most common resolutions include learning something new, getting up early, running every day, and saving money. The start of a new year is the perfect time to ③ turn the page, but one study shows only around 12% of people felt that they were successful in achieving their goals after a year. Like the case of the Sagrada Familia, people who were successful in their resolutions tried many times. Many of these successful persons said they found ways to change their mistakes into opportunities to grow stronger and become better. Now, it's your turn to write about your big project.
